(1) From 14th June 2024 to 5pm, 26th July 2024, any person may inspect the accounting records of the Council for the financial year to 31 March 2024, and certain related documents. They may also make copies of the accounts and documents. These rights are restricted, to prevent access to documents containing information which is protected on the grounds of commercial confidentiality, or containing personal information, under Section 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014.

(2) From 14th June 2024 to 5pm, 26th July 2024, at the request of a local government elector, the local auditor must give the elector, or any representative of the elector, an opportunity to question the auditor about the accounting records of the Council.

(3) From 14th June 2024 to 5pm, 26th July 2024, a local government elector for the area of the Council or his/her representative may objective to the Council's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest or apply for a declaration that an item of accounts is unlawful under Section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. These rights are restricted, to prevent access to documents containing information which is protected on the grounds of commercial confidentiality, or containing personal information, under Section 26 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. Written notice of the proposed objection and the grounds on which it will be made must be sent to the auditor at the address given above or by emailing Grant Thornton UK LLP, 17th Floor, 103 Colmore Row, Birmingham, B3 3AG and also copied to the Council at the address given below.
